Keynote: Elliott Main, MD

We look forward to welcoming our keynote speaker, Dr. Elliott Main, Medical Director of the California Maternal Quality Care Collaborative. Dr. Main chairs the California Pregnancy-Associated Mortality Review Committee and is currently a clinical professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Stanford University. In addition to his involvement in national committees on maternal quality measurement, he helps direct a number of national quality initiatives with ACOG, the CDC, and Maternal Child Health Bureau (HRSA) including the multi-state AIM project. In 2013, Dr. Main received the ACOG Distinguished Service Award for his work in quality improvement.

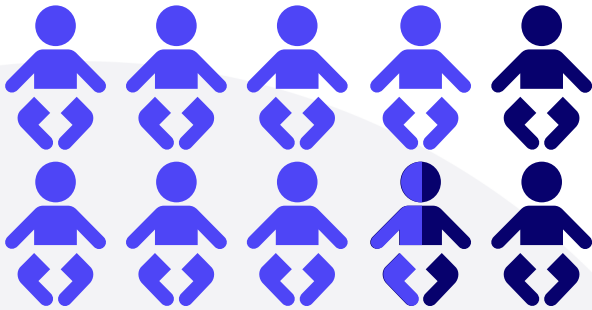
